**PUBLIC NOTICE REGARDING  
A  
REPORT ON CAMEROON BROADCAST  
BY THE CANADIAN TELEVISION CHANNEL TVA**

The High Commission of Cameroon in Canada wishes to bring to the attention of the Cameroonian community and the general public that a report broadcast by the TVA television channel referred to the current situation of the person named OSSOMO NGANDZIGUI, who presents herself as a Cameroonian national whose application for asylum in Canada was rejected by the competent authorities of that country, due to lack of sufficient evidence.

The above-mentioned person claims that her life would be threatened by her husband if she returned to Cameroon. According to her, the husband belongs to a group whose particularity is "to slit the throats of women". In the sequence that was presented, the named OSSOMO NGANDZIGUI, in order to justify her request for asylum, presents Cameroon as a lawless country in which "killings" are perpetrated with impunity and everywhere, without any reaction from the Government.

Following this report, which is currently being published on social networks, the High Commission of Cameroon categorically refutes the assertions of Mrs. OSSOMO NGANDZIGUI, which undermine the image and honourability of Cameroon, which is and remains a State governed by the rule of law, where various violations of laws and regulations are subject to public action by the competent authorities, through impartial investigations and judicial proceedings during which those involved are held accountable for their actions.

The High Commission of Cameroon deplores the fact that a person claiming Cameroonian nationality should allow herself to use outrageous,

insulting, misleading and even delusional statements against her country in order to give credence to her approach, to arouse emotion and to attract sympathy for her.

Consequently, the High Commission calls on the Cameroonian community and the public at large to be vigilant and to discern the various information circulating on social networks and sometimes deliberately disseminated by many media. -
